- 3. Report from FBNS committee
 - First abstract submission deadline was on 10 August
 - 20 abstracts have been submitted as of 14 August
 - 45 registrations
 - Abstract submission deadline extended until 17 August, no more extensions after this date
 - Innovation Forum will be announced after the abstract submission deadline
 - 8 local innovators, established leaders and successful ECRs will contribute to the Innovation Forum
 - A final push for abstract submission is needed

- Aim for 2019: a more structured approach for planning training including specially designed packages for PhD and ECRs
- Ideas for 2019:
 - Time management skills (plan your PhD, plan experiments, etc)
 - Communication training
 - Talent development
 - Grant writing
 - Science text sessions ECRs teaching students/help them with their projects on core elements of research such as statistics or similar
 - Writing skills for honours students or 1st year PhD students
 - Correlative microscopy training for cells or in combination with cell imaging workshop (2017)
 - Illustrator workshop repeat
 - Career development
 - Story telling
